5 CACHE AND CARY

10 HUNT AND PECK


The stars of *Twister* and *To Kill A Mockingbird* type poorly.

Detroit Rock City performers and a legendary crossbow marksman disclose intimate secrets.




WHEEL OF CHANGES

Fill in the inner ring, the outer ring, and the spokes to complete the puzzle.


- +** Add 1 letter



CIRCULAR LOGIC




For each triplet, find the word that can precede or follow each item.
